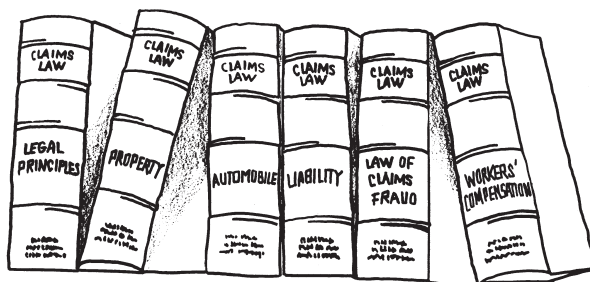

To renew your New Hampshire adjuster's license you are required to complete 30 hours of approved continuing education.
